What is Open Access?

Open Access literature is online, free of charge for all readers and allows the distribution and further use for research, education and other purposes.

Open Access is focused on peer-reviewed scholarly research publications and their pre- and post-prints.

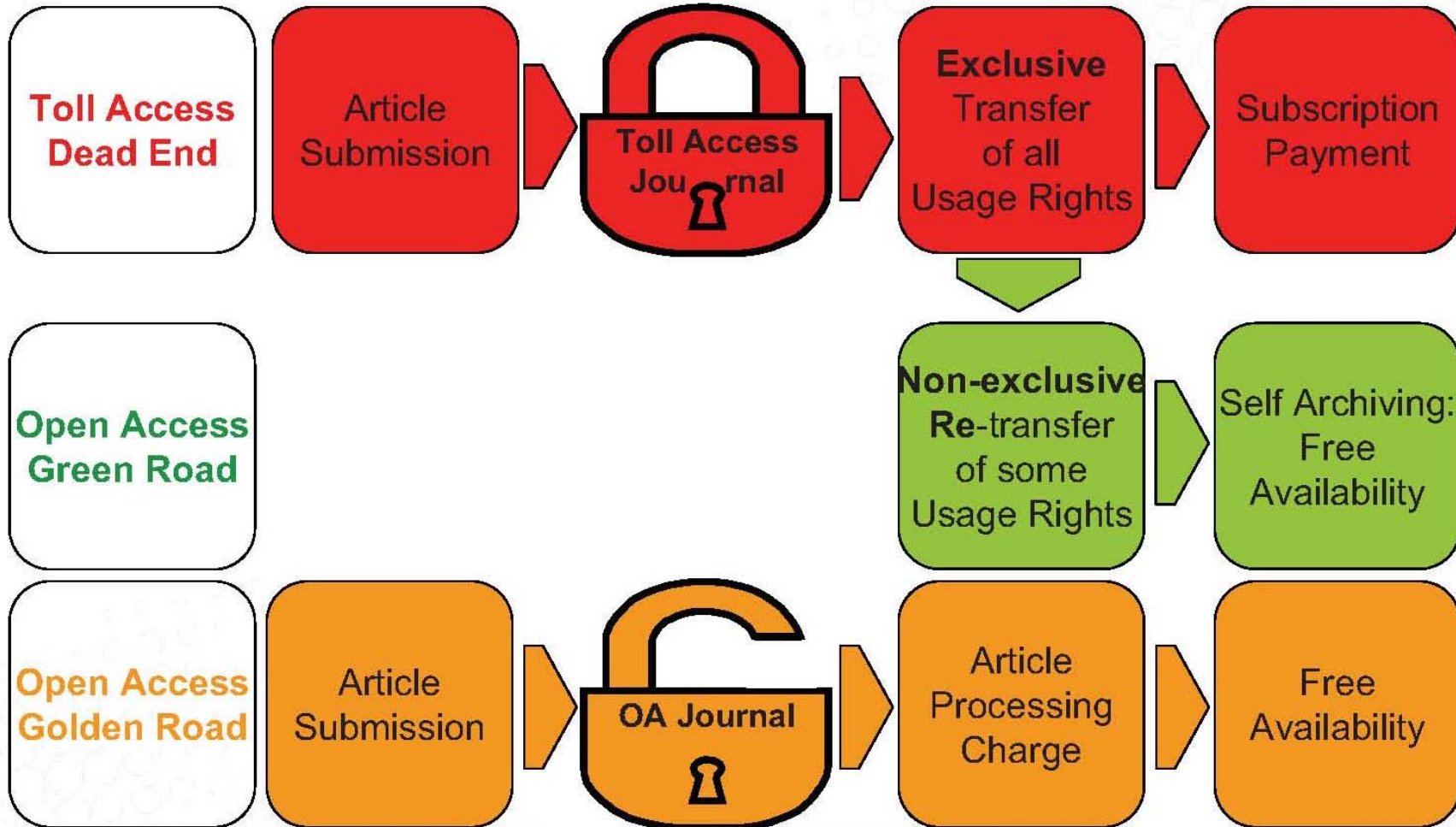


Why Open Access?

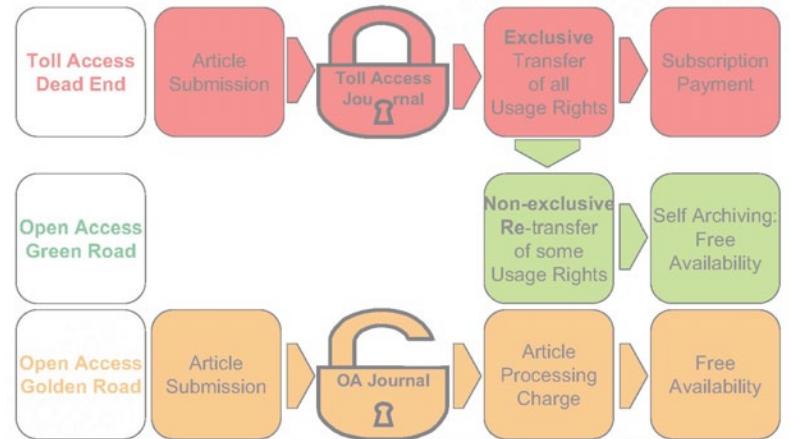
When authors provide Open Access to their work this leads to:

- ✓ Increase of the visibility and accessibility of their research
- ✓ Maximum usage and consequently a potential rise of the citation rate and impact
- ✓ Strengthening of the author position as usage rights often stay with the author of the publication
- ✓ Application of innovative functionalities, e.g. integration of databases, research data or supplementary materials
- ✓ Reduction of access barriers for interdisciplinary research and web-based scholarly communication

Golden Road @ MPS

Using the Golden Road

You want to publish in an Open Access journal:

- Note that there are often article charges!

But those are often paid for by your funders or institution

Other agreements may be stipulated in the Copyright Transfer Agreement. Unless expressly permitted, authors may not post the publisher's version on their own website.

The following describes each of the six main licenses offered when you choose to [publish your work](#) with a Creative Commons license. We have listed them starting with the most accommodating license type you can choose and ending with the most restrictive license type you can choose.

License Conditions

Creators choose a set of conditions they wish to apply to their work.



Attribution

You let others copy, distribute, display, and perform your copyrighted work — and derivative works based upon it — but only if they give credit the way you request.



Share Alike

You allow others to distribute derivative works only under a license identical to the license that governs your work.



Noncommercial

You let others copy, distribute, display, and perform your work — and derivative works based upon it — but for noncommercial purposes only.



No Derivative Works

You let others copy, distribute, display, and perform only verbatim copies of your work, not derivative works based upon it.
